Health insurance	<p>All exchange students have to show proof of health insurance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - EU students need to ask for their European Health Insurance Card before departure - Non-EU students need to enroll to the French Social Security (once in France and after completing their registration at ENSAD Nancy) on this website available in different languages: https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/ <p>[The following documents will be required: a certificate of school enrolment, a passport or ID card, a vital record, a visa or residence permit, a banking information slip ("RIB")]</p>
Liability insurance	<p>Liability insurance is compulsory and covers damages caused by yourself to a third party.
